

**Statutory Definitions of “Minor service & maintenance work”
& “Supply & installation contract” (effective 1/1/2010)**

Local governmental units

§66.0903(1)(dr), Wis. Stats.

(dr) "**Minor service and [or] maintenance work**" means a project of public works that is limited to minor crack filling, chip or slurry sealing, or other minor pavement patching, not including overlays, that has a projected life span of no longer than 5 years; the depositing of gravel on an existing gravel road applied solely to maintain the road; road shoulder maintenance; cleaning of drainage or sewer ditches or structures; or any other limited, minor work on public facilities or equipment that is routinely performed to prevent breakdown or deterioration.

State agencies

§103.49(1)(bj), Wis. Stats.

(bj) "**Minor service and [or] maintenance work**" means a project of public works that is limited to minor crack filling, chip or slurry sealing, or other minor pavement patching, not including overlays, that has a projected life span of no longer than 5 years cleaning of drainage or sewer ditches or structures; or any other limited, minor work on public facilities or equipment that is routinely performed to prevent breakdown or deterioration



All public entities

§§66.0903(1)(im) & 103.49(1)(fm), Wis. Stats.

(im) "**Supply and installation contract**" means a contract under which the material is installed by the supplier, the material is installed by means of simple fasteners or connectors such as screws or nuts and bolts and no other work is performed on the site of the project of public works, and the total labor cost to install the material does not exceed 20 percent of the total cost of the contract.
